



HEALTH GUARANTEE / SALES CONTRACT

HEALTH GUARANTEE:

SECTION #1

A deposit will reserve a puppy for the buyer until the puppy is ready to be shipped by the seller or picked up by buyer. Deposits are NON-REFUNDABLE. The puppy must be paid for in full when personally picked up or 72 hours before the puppy is scheduled to be shipped. Puppies will not be shipped before they are 8-10 weeks old. Every effort will be made by the seller to assure that the puppy is healthy when it is delivered to the buyer including health certificate if shipped, current shots and worming. The buyer is responsible for all medical expenses incurred from the date of delivery.

SECTION #2

The buyer must take the dog to a veterinarian for a complete physical examination within 72 hours of receiving the puppy. The cost of the examination will be paid by the buyer. If the buyer does not take the puppy to a veterinarian in the 72 hours this and all warranty is void. The seller must be notified immediately of the results of the examination. If the veterinarian finds the dog to be a poor health risk or detects any physical health problems that would require further veterinary care, the buyer must notify the seller IMMEDIATELY. A report of the results from the veterinarian must be faxed to the seller within 24 hours. The seller's veterinarian will verify the results.

SECTION #3

The puppy will be guaranteed for one year against any life threatening defects. This includes severe hip dysphasia that requires surgery to correct. It also covers kidney, heart, pancreas, spine, and liver problems of a severe life threatening nature. If the puppy is found to have a life-threatening defect, a complete report from the buyer's veterinarian must be faxed to the seller within 48 hours after the determination. If the puppy dies within this one-year period, the buyer will pay for a necropsy to ascertain the reason for death. If the reason is congenital, the seller will replace the puppy with one of the same value, to be determined by the seller. A replacement puppy may not be available immediately. The buyer will wait until a puppy from a future litter is available. The buyer is responsible for all shipping expenses to and from the seller on a replacement puppy. No monetary refunds will be made. Seller does not cover veterinarian bills. The health guarantee is not valid if the dog has been sold or transferred to a new owner. If the pup in your care has been treated for any injury the contract is null and void. Pup must be seen by a veterinarian in 72 hours for contract to be valid and all paperwork from said veterinarian must be faxed or mailed for contract to be valid.

SECTION #4

The health guarantee does not cover the following: Treatment for internal or external parasites or bacteria, cherry eye, loose hips, loose knees, skin allergies, elongated soft palate, and small or collapsed



nostrils, bad or uneven bites, undescended testicles, demodex, mange, inguinal or umbilical hernias, fleas, ticks, ear mites, coccidia, kennel cough, Giardia, thyroid dysfunction.

SECTION #5

There is no guarantee or warranty that the buyer will be able to show or breed the puppy, regardless of show or breeding potential at the time of purchase. There is no money back if you decide the pup isn't to your liking.

SECTION #6

The puppy comes with [] FULL AKC registration, [] LIMITED AKC registration, [] No AKC registration. Buyer understands this contract is under the jurisdiction of the state of _____, in the County of _____. It is agreed that the place of venue shall be in _____.

We guarantee our puppies/dogs to be in good health to the best of our knowledge. Puppies can be severely stressed by change of environment so make sure you are prepared for the responsibility. Minor stress related problems such as hypoglycemia, coccidiosis or diarrhea are treatable and not a reason for return. Have your veterinarian examine your puppy/dog within 3 days from date of purchase. If his examination reveals a major defect or non-treatable illness, return your puppy/dog with the vets statement and papers for a replacement when available. We do not guarantee against worms, kennel cough, ear mites, demodex, ear and eye infections or cherrie eye as these are common occurrences in dogs and can easily be treated. All veterinary bills are the responsibility of the purchaser. We cannot guarantee the color, size or personality of a puppy/dog.

Continue to worm puppies until 10 - 12 weeks of age.

Puppies need a total of 3 puppy shots dated 3 to 4 weeks apart with final one at 16 weeks. Avoid placing puppies in public areas until all 3 shots are received
